



Criteria for performing total knee arthroplasty without postoperative intensive care monitoring

To perform total knee arthroplasty without postoperative intensive care monitoring, it is necessary for the patient to fulfill the eight criteria defined below:

- 1- Less than 75 years old
- 2- American Society Anesthesiology (ASA) Classification I or II
- 3- Non-smoker
- 4- No history of ischemic disease (Acute Myocardial Infarction and/or Cerebrovascular disease)
- 5- Primary Arthroplasty (CR or PS)
- 6- Body Mass Index (BMI) less than 35 kg/m²
- 7- Creatinine clearance higher than 60 ml/min
- 8- No Sleep Apnea diagnoses
